I hope you have a great summer. Sounds like you'll be keeping busy! This summer I'm heading down to New Mexico to do archaeology in June & July. We will be working in an area that has not been examined for pre-historic evidence yet. This means that we will be systematically walking over the surface of the area & looking for evidence that people used to live there (ex: remains of houses, garbage). We will then put this info. into a computer which will tell us where these locations are on the map. This process is called survey work. It's the first step archaeologists take when investigating the area. Eventually, our findings will be used to figure out where we should dig, but this part will be years down the road.
